

SCHOOL UNIFORM

There is an agreed school uniform and parents are expected to send children to school in the following clothes. The basic colours are grey and red.

Winter Uniform

- White polo shirt
- V neck red sweatshirt or sweatshirt cardigan with school logo
- Charcoal grey trousers, skirt or pinafore dress
- Flat, black school shoes (no trainers)
- Grey school socks (boys), white socks or grey tights (girls)
- Red book bag with school logo (up to Year 2)

Summer Uniform

- For girls red gingham dress and white socks
- For boys white polo shirt, charcoal grey trousers or shorts

<u>P.E.</u>

- Red PE bag
- House colour T-shirt
- Black/Navy blue plain shorts
- Plimsolls or trainers
- Tracksuit bottoms/joggers in navy or black
- Shinpads for Years 5 and 6 (and mouthguards are strongly recommended for hockey and rugby)
- Optional house colour sweatshirt / navy or black plain sweatshirt

Outdoor Learning

Clothing appropriate to the activity should be worn, ie: clothes that can get muddy, wet, and are suitable for the weather conditions (ie. warm tops, wellies, sun hats, etc.) Where possible this should be school P.E. kit, however, we appreciate that on some weeks, it may be necessary to wear alternative clothing if outdoor learning is in addition to regular P.E. sessions. Under no circumstances should denim be worn for P.E. or outdoor learning; tops must have sleeves and cover childrens' midrifts.

Hairbands should be in the school colours of red, white or grey, or plain black, with **no embellishments**. Jewellery and nail varnish are not permitted in school, with the exception of small, stud earrings.
